

TWILIGHT PHOTO SHOOT CHECK-LIST

Twilight photography is the perfect way to highlight a great city skyline, waterfront views, decorative lighting, or a fantastic outdoor entertaining space. Capture a beautiful sunset or a lighted pool under a starry sky to leave potential buyers with an unforgettable image.

- ☐ Turn on all interior and exterior lights
- ☐ Don't forget pools and decorative lighting
- ☐ Flood lights & motion lights should be placed in the off position
- ☐ Replace any bulbs that are not in working order (prior to appointment)
- ☐ Shades, blinds & curtains should be placed in an open position for optimal effect
- ☐ Vehicles should either be parked in a closed garage or away from the property
- ☐ Stray objects should be hidden from view prior to the photographer's arrival

PLEASE BE ADVISED: there is an extremely limited window of time to capture twilight images prior to full darkness. Delays due to the property not being ready may result in cancellation or less final images. Outcomes may vary due to the nature of varying lighting conditions.
