You may have some questions about MLH Fellowship, so here are a few you might be thinking about

I am International, do I qualify?

In many cases, yes! You do still qualify for this opportunity, even if you are not based in the USA. You may need some additional forms and documentation completed by the MLH staff, but the best way to find out is to ask your higher education institution.

When do I start the process?

Each higher education institution is different. For college or university credit you may need to get approval prior to starting the program. For internship credit you may be able to submit all information at the end of the program. Inquire with your career counselor about what your insitution needs.

How many credits do I get?

This depends - based on the amount of hours you are doing within the Fellowship, the type of credit your seeking (class vs. internship), and what your higher institution allows. Typically MLH sees 1-2 credit hours awarded.

Have students done this before?

Many former Fellows have used this program to qualify for college/university or internship credit. The MLH team has worked with Fellows from across the globe to ensure that those interested in using this program can earn credit.

What documentation do I need?

Depending on your institution and the type of credit you apply for (college or internship), the type of documentation you need differs. The MLH team will work with you and your higher education institution to ensure that all forms and documentation are completed fully.
