

Online Teaching Dress Code:

Educators are expected to maintain a neat and professional appearance at all times. This includes well-groomed hair and the adherence to the following:

- All undergarments must be worn discreetly beneath clothing.
- Your face should be visible at all times and not blocked with sunglasses or hats.
- Attire should ensure coverage of the chest and shoulder area.
- Midriffs should be covered, ensuring no skin is exposed between pants and shirt.
- Tops with shoulder straps of sufficient width to provide adequate coverage are allowed, even if they leave the shoulders exposed. However, spaghetti straps are not permitted.
- Clothing should refrain from displaying language or imagery of a sexual, political, or potentially controversial nature.
- Only small and acceptable logos are permitted on clothing; embellishments that enhance personal style are encouraged.
