

How to Register for the SAT

1. Create a College Board Account

If you already have an account, log in, and proceed to step 2.

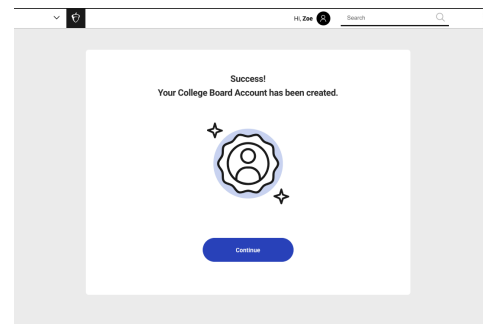
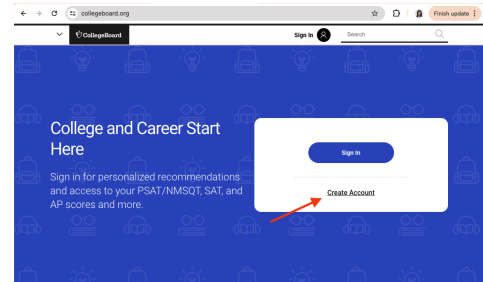
If you do not already have a College Board account, go to collegeboard.org and create a **Student account**.

- If you think you already have an account but are not sure, please check, because you should only have one College Board account.

Fill out your personal and parent information.

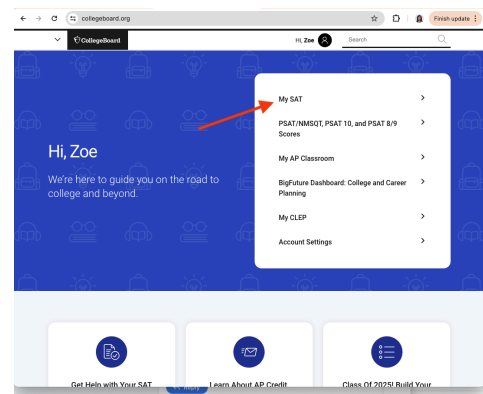
Once you confirm all your information, you will get a verification code sent to your email. After you put in the code, you can set up your password and security phrase.

After that, your College Board has been successfully created.

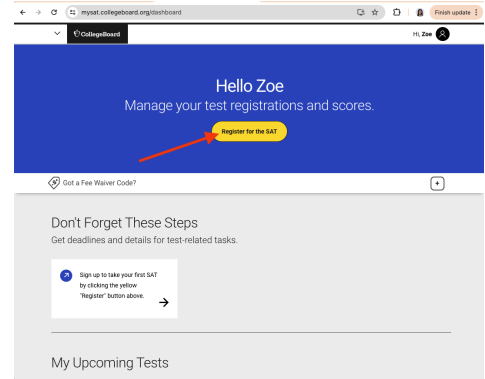


2. Go to My SAT

Once you are logged in, go to My SAT.



On the next page, click the yellow button that says "Register for the SAT"



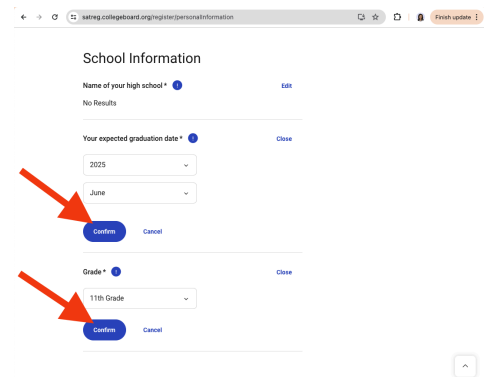
3. Entering your information

On this first page, most of the information will be autofilled.

Confirm your graduation date and grade.

If anything here needs to be changed (Student Information, Contact Information), you will have to go into your account settings and change it from there.

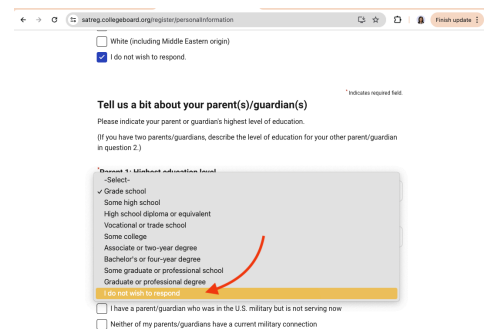
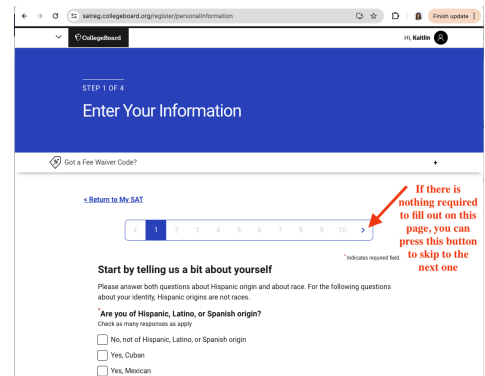
Proceed to the next page.



4. Entering your information (continued)

On the next ten pages, you will be asked a lot of personal questions. For most of these pages, you can skip and leave the questions blank. This will not affect your scores or college admissions.

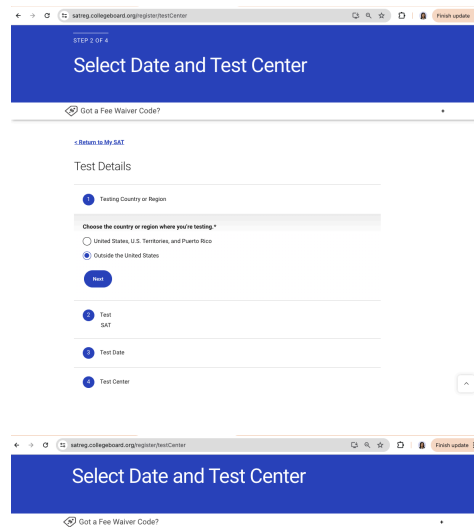
The only questions you have to answer are the ones with an asterisk * next to them. If you do not know the answer to these questions, you can select "I do not wish to respond." Again, this does not affect your scores.



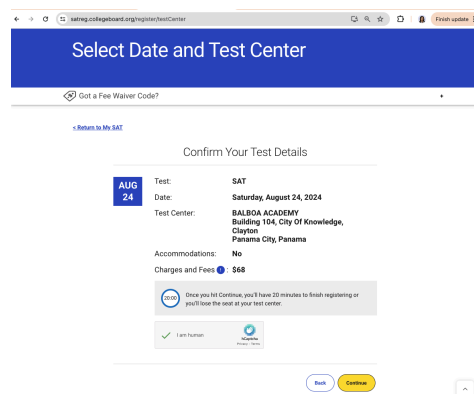
5. Selecting your date and test center.

After you skip through all the personal questions, you will be taken to a terms and conditions page. Scroll through the whole document, accept the terms, and then press continue.

Then you can select where and when you want to take the SAT. You can only select one exam date in this registration session. If you are looking to register for multiple exam dates, after you complete this registration, you can go ahead and start the process again and select the next date you want to register for.

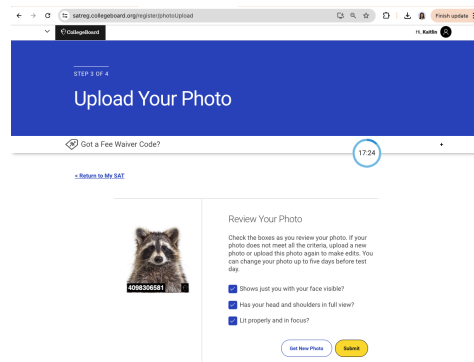


After that, confirm your registration details.



6. Upload your photo

Next, upload a photo of yourself. It should be passport-style, meaning a clear photo of yourself from the shoulders up, facing the camera, with a simple background. You only have to upload the photo the first time you register for the SAT.



7. Select your test day device

Since the SAT is given digitally, select the device you plan to take the exam on. If you are unsure, you can select "I haven't decided."

8. Checking out

Review all your registration information and put in the payment for the exam.

The SAT costs \$68 if you are taking it in the United States, and \$111 if you are taking it outside of the United States.

9. Final steps

Once you pay for the exam, you are officially registered!

Download the Bluebook app onto the device that you will be taking the SAT exam on.

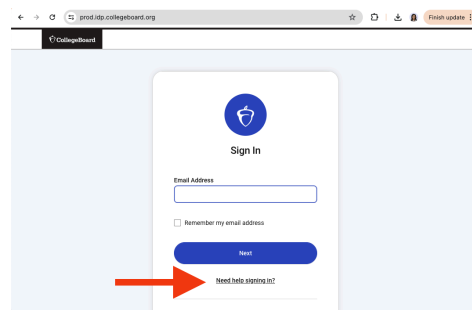
Do not wait till the day of the exam to do this! The Bluebook app is also where your registration ticket will be, which you will need on exam day.

On exam day, bring your testing device with Bluebook downloaded on it, and a photo ID with you.

Common questions and issues when registering for the SAT:

I cannot log into my College Board.

- On the sign-in page, click “Need help signing in?” to reset the password.
- If you do not get the email to reset the password, try using your other email accounts too, just in case you made the account with the other email.

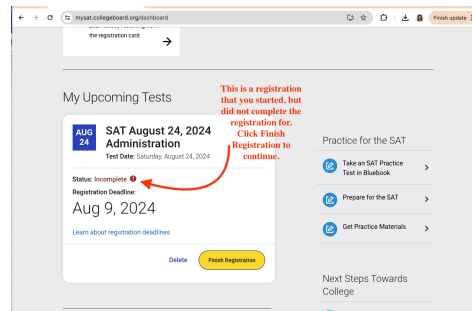


The College Board is not accepting my address when I am creating my account or putting in payment information.

- If your address is too long, the College Board will not accept it. Try abbreviating or moving part of the address to line 2.
- Special characters, (#, commas, periods) and characters with accent marks (for example, ã, é) are also not allowed so replace or delete those characters.
- The address should be as close to accurate as possible, but these small changes are okay. You will not be receiving any physical mail from the College Board.

I do not see the test date I am looking for.

- Make sure it is not past the registration deadline. You can view SAT deadlines here: <https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/sat/dates-deadlines>
- If that is still not the case, it is likely that you already started a registration for that exam but did not complete it. Go back to the MySAT page. Scroll past the yellow “Register for the SAT” button down to “My Upcoming Tests.” There you should see the registration for the exam date you were looking for that says “Finish Registration.” When you click that, you will pick up where you left off.



There is no more space at the test center that I want to test at.

- You can ask your high school if they can open up more seats for you. If the high school allows it and agrees to open more space, you should register as soon as possible before the seats get filled up again. If they do not allow this, then you will have to test elsewhere.
 - If you are a student with extra time accommodations, you will have to ask your school to open up more seats specifically for students with extra time accommodations.

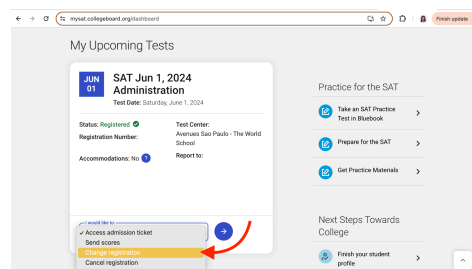
I can only take the SAT on Sundays, not Saturdays, due to religious reasons.

- Then after your testing status is changed to Sundays, continue with the steps in this current document.

Can I change my test center after I register?

[Check to see the deadline](#) to make any changes. There is a \$29 fee to change the test center. [Click here to view fees.](#)

If you need to move test centers, and if it is before the final deadline to make changes, then yes, you can. Go to the MySAT page, scroll down to your registration.



Click on the dropdown underneath the words “I would like to” to change the registration.

Can I cancel my exam after registering?

Yes, and you will get refunded for the exam, but there is a cancellation fee, depending on which deadline has passed. [Check to see the deadlines.](#) [Click here to view fees.](#)

To cancel, go to the MySAT page, scroll down to your registration. Click on the dropdown underneath the words “I would like to” to cancel the registration.

Can I change my test date after registering?

To do this, you will have to cancel the exam registration (see question above), and then start a new registration for the date you want.
