# 2. Information We Collect by Automated Means

2.1 The Backpack Exchange Group is made up of different legal entities, including Trek Labs Ltd., Trek Labs Ltd FZE, Trek Labs Australia Pty Ltd, Trek Labs Inc., etc. When we refer to Backpack Exchange, we, us and our, we refer to the relevant company in the Backpack Exchange Group responsible for processing the personal data collected through the cookie. We will let you know which entity will be the controller for your personal data when you sign up to our Services with us.

2.2 When we refer to users, your and you, we mean users of our Services (as defined below).

2.3 When you visit <u>www.backpack.exchange</u> (the **Site**), view or click on our online advertisements (including our advertisements on third party websites), visit our social media pages or download and use one of our mobile applications (our **Services**), we collect certain information including, but not limited to, internet protocol (IP) address, browser type and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform, device data, MAC address, and other technology on the devices you use to access this website.

# 3. Technologies We Use

We use the following types of cookies:
