Notice Regarding Price Increases

To date, we have received confirmed price increases for raw materials for March and April, as well as preliminary indicative increases for May. These increases are linked to the war situation in the Middle East and remain too speculative to be confirmed.

- Good news: Supply is not at risk.
- Challenge: The impact on prices could be significant if the situation does not stabilize.

In accordance with our 30-day notice policy, we are therefore announcing a price increase scheduled for **April 20, 2026**.

At this time, the information we have indicates a potential increase of over 10%, but these figures are changing rapidly—sometimes every two days—due to the international context.

To avoid speculation, the final percentage will be confirmed before the effective date and will be based exclusively on actual costs and data available at that time.

Until then, you can place your usual orders **at the current price**, with standard delivery times.

Fuel Surcharge

Please note that the fuel surcharge policy will take effect as of **March 30, 2026**. As in the past, this surcharge will apply only to the portion exceeding the usual price per litre.

Additional Information

Due to the current instability and in order to protect our existing customers, we are implementing a **30-day protection policy** to ensure the stability of our service and safeguard your operations.

Therefore, for the next month, Styrorail will not:

- Accept any new customers.
- Submit any major project bids with a price lock exceeding 15 days.
