Simpson Strong-Tie Canada remains committed to providing consistent, reliable pricing for our customers, and we have a robust **continuous improvement** effort designed to offset higher costs beyond our control by maximizing efficiency in the areas we can control. A price list reflecting our new pricing will be sent next week, which **will be effective on Monday March 16, 2026**.

The Federal Government announced a new tariff on December 26, 2025, that effects all steel derivative products entering Canada.

Product categories imported from outside of North America will incur a 10% tariff-based price increase.

Anchor Systems:

Drill bits, Powder and Gas Actuated Fasteners/Tools, Mechanical Anchors

Fasteners:

Structural Fasteners, Stainless Fasteners, QuikDrive fasteners and tools

No change to Connectors, Truss Plates, Software and Services pricing.

The current environment driving tariff policy is fluid, so if further policy changes occur, we may need to re-evaluate accordingly, and prices on affected products may change.

We recognize that higher prices are not welcome in an environment where affordability is the principal driver of a sluggish construction market. We have been and will continue to do our best to minimize those increases. During the period leading to the price increase, we will monitor the size of stock orders to ensure that all customers receive the product they need to meet normal demand.
